The following is a run down of what was accomplished in Menominee Township this past year:

1. We spent \$31,837.00 on roads.
 - A. Chip sealed 1 mile of road using a different material.
No dust this time – time will tell how well it lasts.
 - B. Crack sealed 3 miles of road.
 - C. Applied dust control brine 2+ times.
2. Purchased a projection system for use at the township hall.
3. Purchase a bench for the cemetery.
4. Provided sample water tests for 47 wells.
5. Continued to clean up and improve the park behind the township hall.
6. There was \$2,420,800.00 of new construction in the township.
7. Submitted grant application for a bridge on Fairland Loop Road. Grant was denied.
8. Our Planning Commission has been meeting regularly and is getting close to formulating the Master Plan for Menominee Township. We appreciate all the time and effort they have put forth. Public input and participation is always welcome.

Because of State budget reductions, we had to slow down on spending this year to build-up for next year. 2011 will be busier with more spent on roads.

I want to thank my fellow board members for all their work in helping to make Menominee Township a good example of folks working together for the common good.

Finally, with all that has happened in the world in just the last month, let's just stop and reflect on how blessed we are to be where we are – right here in Menominee Township!
